STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS No. 38 OF 2014

## ORDER

MADE by the Minister under section 5 of the Peace Preservation Act (Chap. 15:04).

### **INDEPENDENCE CARNIVAL ORDER, 2014.**

2. In this Order unless the context otherwise requires -

Interpretation.

“weapon of offence” includes any firearm, cutlass, knife, stick, stone, bottle, either empty or containing liquid of any description and any article or thing capable of being used for offensive purposes;

“noisy instrument” includes any apparatus, device, musical instrument or radio by means of which sounds may be mechanically or electronically produced or reproduced.

3.(1) On Tuesday the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2014 hereinafter referred to as “the Carnival day”, persons decently clothed and conducting themselves in an orderly manner may take part in the Carnival between the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.
