PROCLAMATION OF THE BOUNDARIES FOR RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SALISBURY VILLAGE COUNCIL

It is notified for general information that in accordance with the provisions of section Chapter 190: Part (1) of the 15th November, 2021

Village Council Ordinance, that the understated are being proclaimed as the boundaries, for the purpose of the reestablishment of the Salisbury Village Council:-

- NORTH: By the Batalie River starting from the mouth of the Batalie River to a point on the said Batalie River near En L'ilet, approximately 4.5 miles up the Batalie River;
- SOUTH: By the Macoucherie River starting from the mouth of the Macoucherie River to a point on the said river near Petite Macoucherie, approximately 6.25 miles up the Macoucherie River;
- WEST: By the Sea from the mouth of the Macoucherie River to the mouth of the Batalie River;
- EAST: By a line that proceeds from Petite Macoucherie to Macatrin Valley from a point 4.5 miles up the Batalie River to a point approximately 6.25 miles up the Macoucherie River.

In accordance with the provisions of Section Chapter 190: Part (1) of the Village Council Ordinance, I hereby proclaim the above stated as the boundaries for the purpose of the establishment of the Salisbury Village Council.
