APROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 3(1) of the Emergency Powers (Disaster) Act, Chapter 15:03 that where Dominica or any part thereof is affected or is imminently likely to be affected by a disaster, the President may, by proclamation which shall be published in the *Gazette*, declare that a state of emergency exists in Dominica or any portion thereof;

WHEREAS section 17(3) of the Constitution of Dominica, set out in Schedule 1 of the Commonwealth of Dominica Constitution Order 1978 (S.I. No. 1027, U.K.), provides that a proclamation declaring a state of public emergency in Dominica shall not be effective unless it contains a declaration that the President is satisfied -
