BY-LAW No. 10 of 2025.

BY-LAW

MADE by the Salisbury Village Council under section 18 of the Village Council Ordinance, (Chapter 190) to provide for the lopping and cutting of trees and confirmed by the Minister under section 19 of the said Ordinance.

1. The By-Law may be cited as the -

Short title.

SALISBURY VILLAGE COUNCIL CUTTING OF TREES BY-LAW, 2025

2. The Council may, by notice in writing served on the occupier of any land, order such occupier within a specified time, to be stated in the notice, to cut down, lop or trim growing trees on such lands which in the opinion of the Council is dangerous to human life or property.

3. If the occupier of the land upon whom such notice is served does not comply with the order of the Council within the time specified therein, it shall be lawful for the Council to cause such tree to be cut down, lopped or trimmed, as the case may be.
