

COMMONWEALTH OF DOMINICA

BY-LAW No. 15 of 2025.

BY-LAW

MADE by the Salisbury Village Council under section 18 of the Village Council Ordinance (Chapter 190) to provide for the control of animals within the village of Salisbury and confirmed by the Minister under section 19 of the said Ordinance.

(Gazetted 24th July, 2025.)

1. This BY-LAW shall be cited as the-

Short title.

SALISBURY VILLAGE COUNCIL ANIMAL CONTROL BY-LAW

2. (a) No person shall allow any animal other than a cat to be at large and not under control within the limits of the village of Salisbury.

Control of animals.

(b) No person shall purposely tie any animal along village roads and public spaces, in proximity to destroy fruit trees, flowers, palms planted for the purpose of beautification or for human food.

3. The burial of animals shall be the responsibility of the owner; however, the Council shall reserve the right to bury dead animals found in any public space.

Burial of dead animals.

4. The owner of any such animal found at large and not under control within and limits of the village shall be guilty of an offence under this by-law and shall be liable to summary conviction and a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00) and five dollars
