Integrity in Public Office Act 2003, No.6 of 2003 And Integrity in Public Office (Amendment) Act, 2015, No. 21 of 2015

FILING OF DECLARATIONS OF FINANCIAL AFFAIRS BY PERSONS IN PUBLIC LIFE FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2017

According to the Act, a person in public life is required to file a declaration in Form 2, with the Integrity

Commission within three (3) months after the end of the calendar year. Therefore, for calendar year **2017**, all financial declarations must be filed with the Commission no later than **March 31**ST **2018**.

The FORM 2 declaration shall set out for the person in public life:

- (a) office or offices;
- (b) income, assets and liabilities;
- (c) assets of the spouse, children or relative acquired through or traceable to the person's income; and
- (d) gifts made by him/her in value exceeding one thousand dollars.

Where the person in public life (the declarant) holds money or property in trust for another, he/she is also supposed to state this in the declaration.

The Act requires the Commission to examine every declaration and, where that may be necessary for the conduct of the examination, to request from the declarant any information or explanation.

In the event of non-compliance, section 22 of the Act provides as follows:
