#### APPOINTMENT OF PRESIDING OFFICER/ SUPERVISOR FOR THE ST. JOSEPH VILLAGE COUNCIL GENERAL ELECTION

The general public is informed that Ms. Yonica Nelson is appointed Presiding Officer/Supervisor for the St. Joseph Village Council General Election, in accordance with Section 41(1) of the Village Council Ordinance, Chapter 190 of the Revised Laws of Dominica (1961).

Nomination day is the 16<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2016 and the Presiding Officer/Supervisor will be available at the Village Council's Office in St. Joseph, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to receive the nomination of candidates. On that day, the completed nomination documents must be delivered to the Presiding Officer/Supervisor no later than 4:00 p.m.

Every candidate must be named and designated by his full name and residence, in the nomination paper by two duly qualified voters, and the person so named must express in writing on the nomination paper, his consent to such nomination.

Every candidate for election must deliver, or cause to be delivered to the Presiding Officer/Supervisor, at the time of presenting his nomination paper, a declaration in writing signed by him, stating the qualifications possessed
