(RE-ISSUE)

SKELETON ARGUMENTS AND LISTS
OF AUTHORITIES

This practice direction is made pursuant to Rule 4.2(1) of the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court Civil Procedures Rules 2000.

Practice direction 62(D), No. 10 of 2011 is revoked and substituted by this practice direction.

1. INTRODUCTION
 - 1.1 This practice direction supplements Rule 62.11.
 - 1.2 Skeleton arguments and lists of authorities must be lodged either in support of or in opposition to every application or appeal. A skeleton argument should be concise and succinct. It should at the same time be comprehensive, in that, it should state all the points which a legal practitioner intends to raise and summarize the argument on each of those points. A point not raised or argument not advanced in a party's skeleton argument may not be pursued at the hearing of the application or appeal without the leave of the court.
