### DEPARTMENTAL AND OTHER NOTICES

INTEGRITY IN PUBLIC OFFICE ACT 2003, NO. 6 OF 2003:  
FILING OF DECLARATIONS OF FINANCIAL AFFAIRS  
BY PERSONS IN PUBLIC LIFE BY 31<sup>ST</sup> MARCH 2015

Under sections 16(1) and (6) of the Integrity in Public Office Act 2003, a person in public life (holding or acting in any office or position set out in Part 1, and a person acting for a period of not less than six (6) months in an office set out in Part 2 of the First Schedule to the Act), is required to complete and file a declaration with the Integrity Commission within three (3) months after the end of each calendar year. The declarations shall be in Form 2 of the Third Schedule to the Act.

The 2014 calendar year ended on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 2014. In respect of calendar year 2014, all declarations must be filed with the Commission no later than the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March 2015.

Section 16 (4) of the Act, which also deals with the filing of declarations, provides that “...A person who becomes a person in public life after the commencement of this Act shall, not later than three months of his becoming a person in public life, file a declaration in Form 2 of the Third Schedule with the Commission.”

Section 20 of the Act, which deals with secrecy and confidentiality, provides: “The declarations filed with the Commission and the records of the Commission in respect of those declarations are secret and confidential and shall
