STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS No. 3 OF 2014

ORDER

MADE by the Minister under section 5 of the Peace Preservation Act, (Chap. 15:04).

(Gazetted 27th February, 2014.)

1. This Order may be cited as the -

Short title.

CARNIVAL ORDER, 2014.

2. In this Order unless the context otherwise requires -

Interpretation.

“fireworks” includes explosives locally known as bombs or anything of a like kind or nature;

“sensay type costume” means a costume, which is made of scraps of cloth, paper, crocus bags, or any other similar material and includes the mask used with the costume,

“weapon” includes any firearms, cutlass, knife, stick, stone, bottle (either empty or containing liquid of any description), and any article or thing capable of being used for offensive purposes.

3. (1) On Monday the 3rd day of March, 2014 and Tuesday the 4th day of March, 2014 (hereinafter referred to as “the Carnival days”) persons decently clothed and conducting themselves in an orderly manner may take part in the Carnival between the hours of 4.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. on Monday, 3rd March, 2014 and between 8.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. on Tuesday, 4th March, 2014.
